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
- Ankle & Foot injuries
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Post-Op Instructions for Wart or Soft Tissue Mass Removal

Beginning tomorrow:

You may bathe or shower. Remove the dressing. Clean the surgical area with warm, soapy water.

Dry well. Apply antibiotic ointment (Bacitracin or triple antibiotic ointment); gauze and may use Band-Aids, tape or Coban to secure the dressing.

We **DO NOT** recommend Neosporin. No Band-Aids directly to the surgical site.

As the drainage slows and the wound is comfortable, remove the dressing while sleeping and apply a fresh dressing in the morning.

Continue these instructions until your next scheduled appointment.

Call the office if any excessive bleeding or drainage occurs. Some pain is normal – you make take Tylenol if needed.
